The World Spina Bifida and Hydrocephalus Day (WSBHD) has been established and designated by the International Federation for Spina Bifida and Hydrocephalus' (IF) General Meeting in Guatemala in 2011 with the aim of raising awareness and understanding about Spina Bifida and Hydrocephalus (SBH).

It also serves as a means to advocate and promote the rights of persons with these conditions. The WSBHD was held for the first time on 25 October 2012 at the European Parliament in Strasbourg.

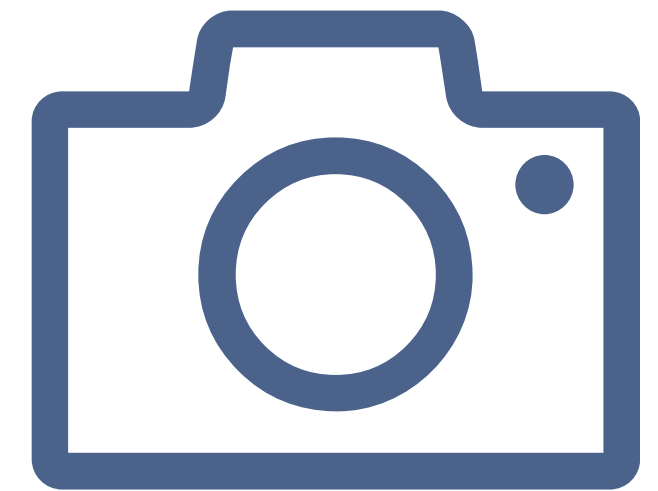

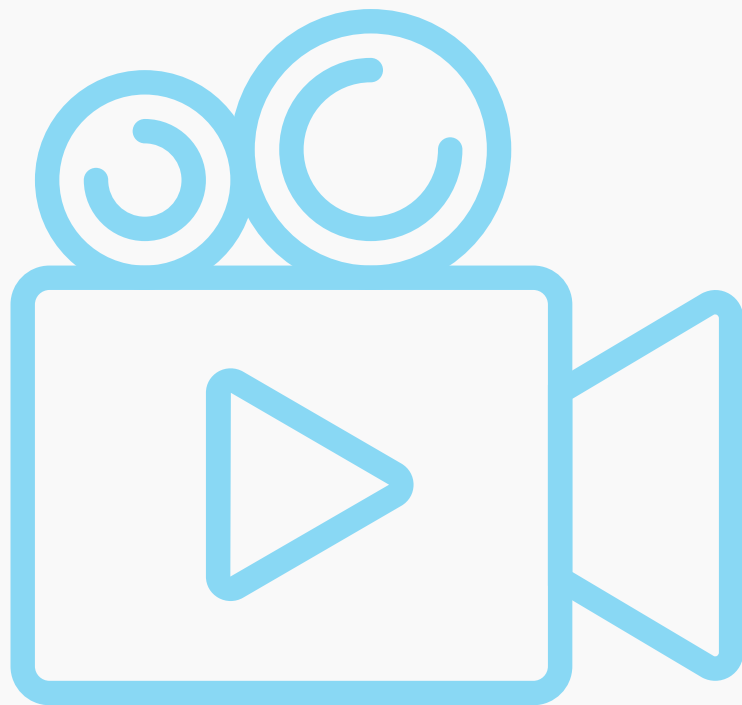

Record a video!



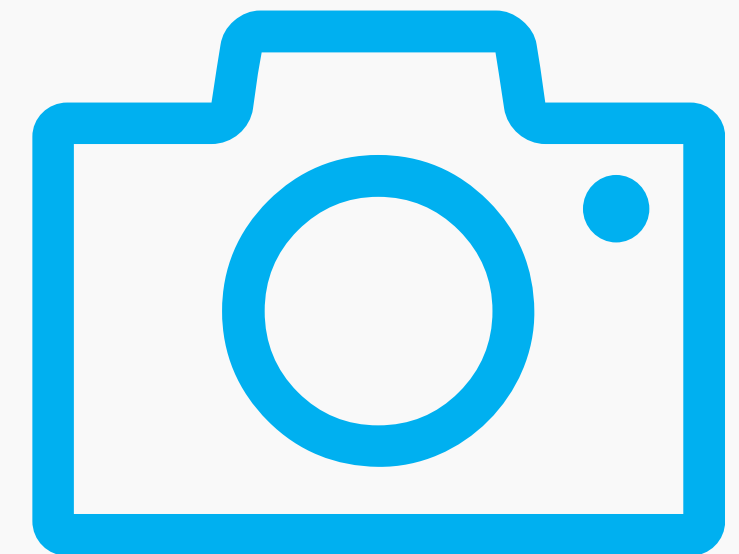
OPTION 2

- Access to adequate social services and living independently, are basic human rights and key to the survival of persons with disabilities.

- We should continue joining forces to ensure that the rights of persons with Spina Bifida and Hydrocephalus are respected in accordance with the UNCRPD!
- The [#UNCRPD](#) states that persons with disabilities have the right to the highest attainable standard of health. Advocate for accessible healthcare for all!
- Physical barriers and lack of appropriate support makes persons with disabilities feel isolated and can harm their mental health. Ensure [#inclusion](#) to make integrated care accessible.
- Lack of access to essential goods and services, in particular in the areas of health and rehabilitation, can cause additional, life-threatening, situations. Promote inclusion for all!
