Join us to Celebrate the World Spina Bifida and Hydrocephalus on 25 October!

Brussels | 1 October 2025

The 25th October 2025 marks the World Spina Bifida and Hydrocephalus Day (WSBHD). We established this day in 2011 to raise awareness and understanding about Spina Bifida and Hydrocephalus (SBH). It also serves as a means to advocate and promote the rights of persons with these conditions.

This year's theme is 'Accelerate Action for Spina Bifida and Hydrocephalus'.

Individuals with SBH continue to face numerous barriers, including stigma, discrimination, and a widespread lack of awareness — all of which limit full participation in life's opportunities. Addressing these challenges and accelerating action on key issues affecting the SBH community is more important than ever.

During this year's WSBHD on October 25, we will raise further awareness on how we, as a global community, can work together to achieve this goal. This call to accelerate action is also underscored in the recent <u>Kuala Lumpur Declaration</u>, which IF launched with its co-signatories during the Global Disability Summit. The Declaration advocates for concrete measures to advance disability rights for persons with SBH, reinforcing the urgency of collective commitment and action.
